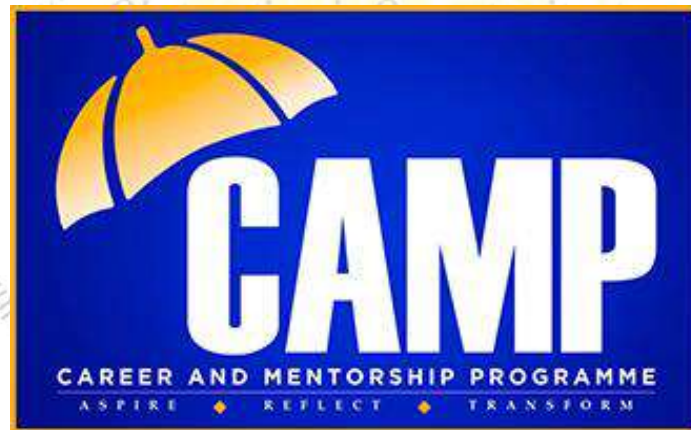

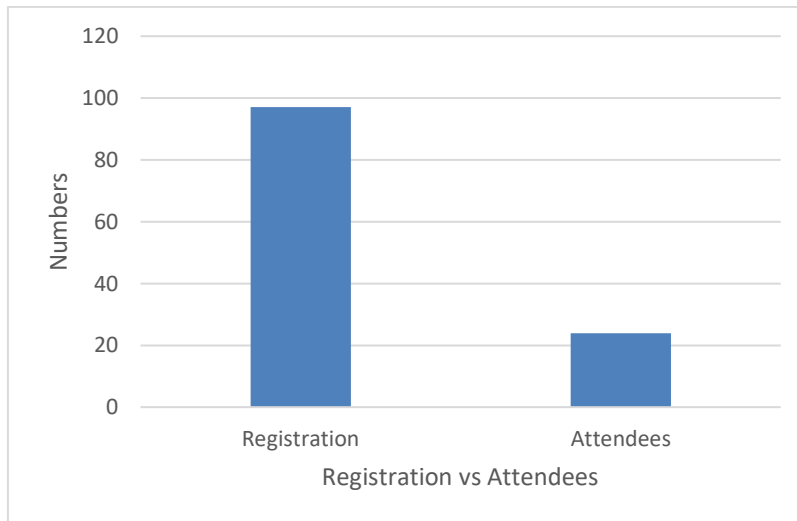
SUMMARY

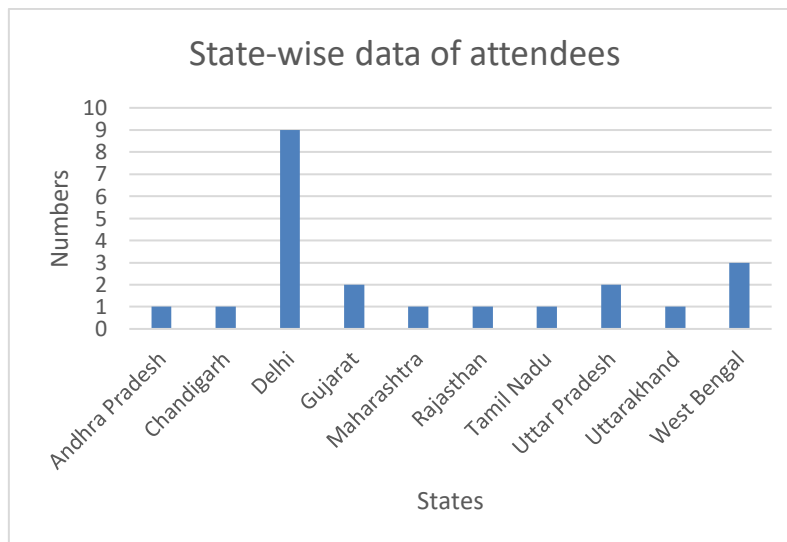

HIGHLIGHTS

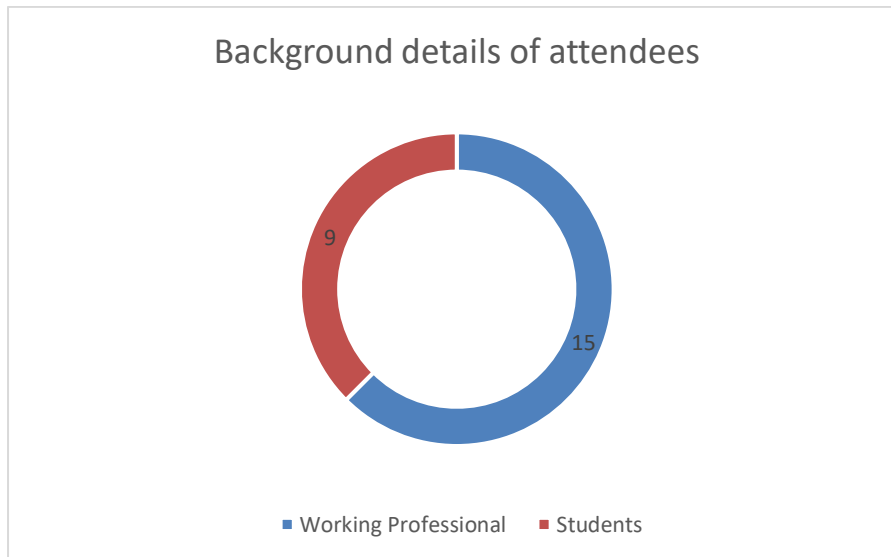
- There were 97 registrations made and 24 attendees attended the session out of which 75% were female and 25% were male.
