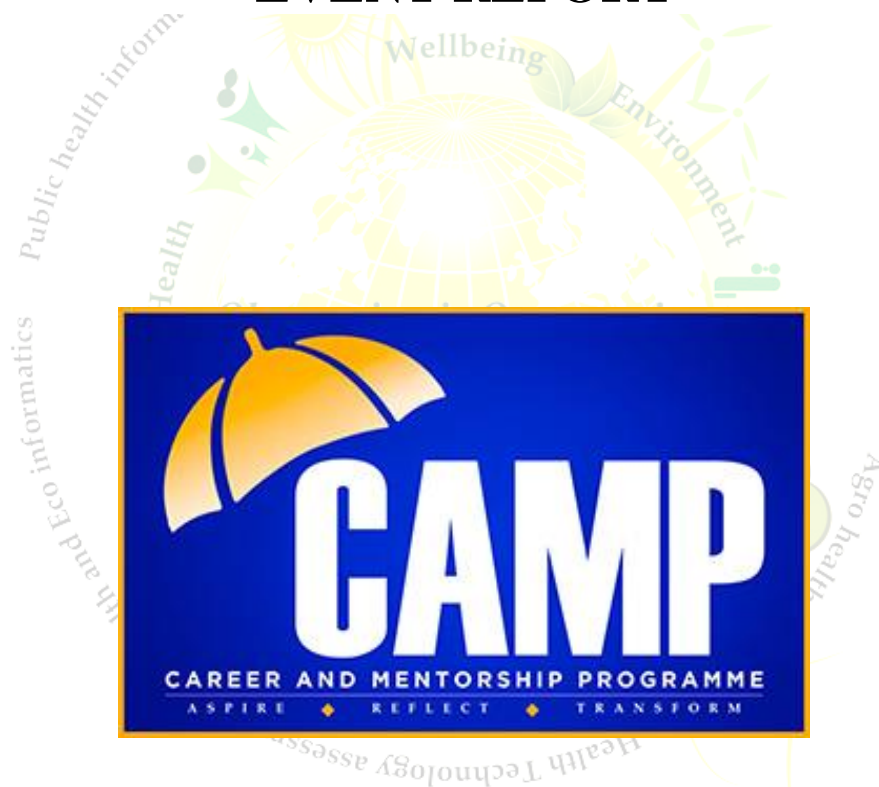

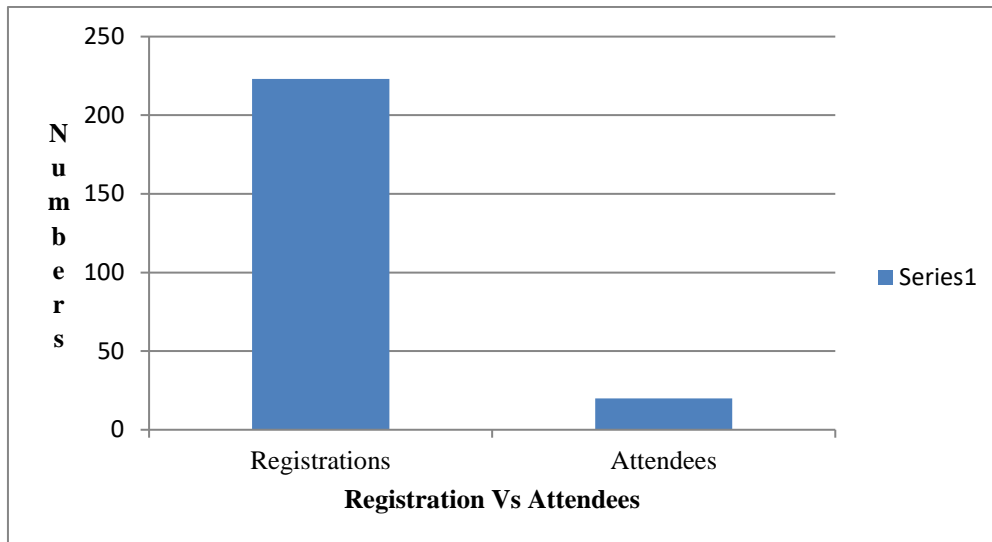
SUMMARY

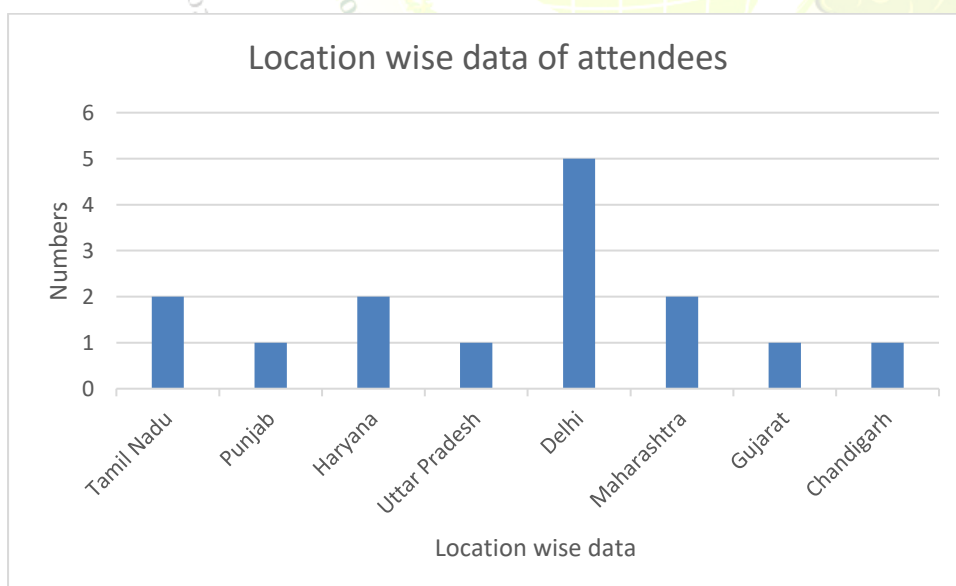

HIGHLIGHTS

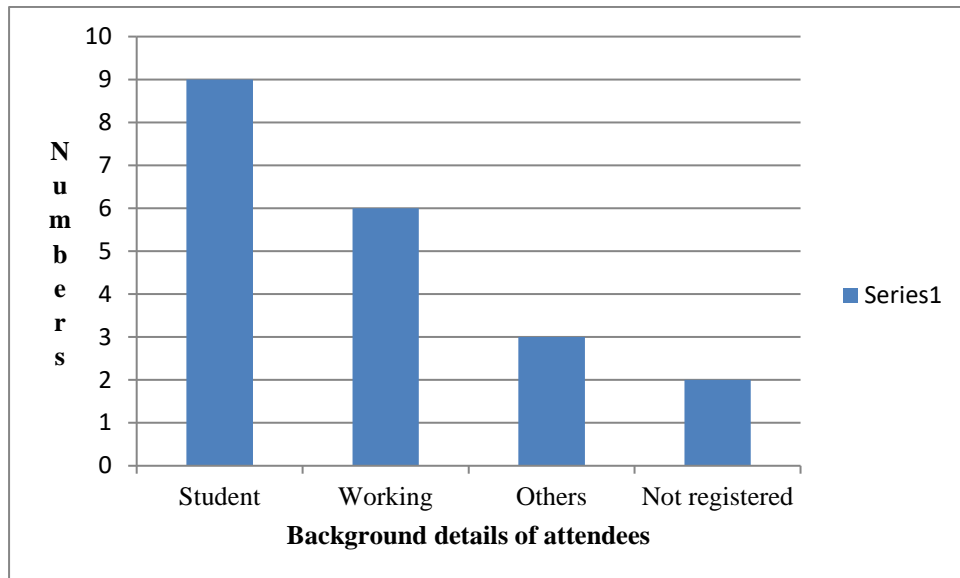
- There were 213 registrations made and 20 attendees attended the session out of which which 80% were female and 20% were male.



- Positive participation was seen during the mid-quiz and end-quiz time.

WEBINAR

The speaker of the session was Dr. Heemanshu Aurora. The session focussed on Public Health ethics, Scope of ethical guidelines, Responsible conduct of research and Benefit risk assessment. The event had 3 quiz sessions: pre-quiz, mid-quiz, and end-quiz. The attendees participated actively in the quiz. It was an interactive session with a post-presentation Q&A session. The following questions were discussed in depth during the event:

1. If the research is not Biomedical research / clinical trials but will be a kind of questionnaires or asking vital statistics, still the consent required or any other ethics? And also for that, we has to follow ICMR ethics guidelines?
A. An informed consent form is mandatory and essential in most studies involving human subjects as it is a primary vehicle for the disclosure of information. For research involving human participants ICMR ethics guidelines have to be followed.
2. Can you explain a little bit regarding inclusion and exclusion criteria in research manuscript?
A. Inclusion and the exclusion criteria are a part of research design of the proposal.

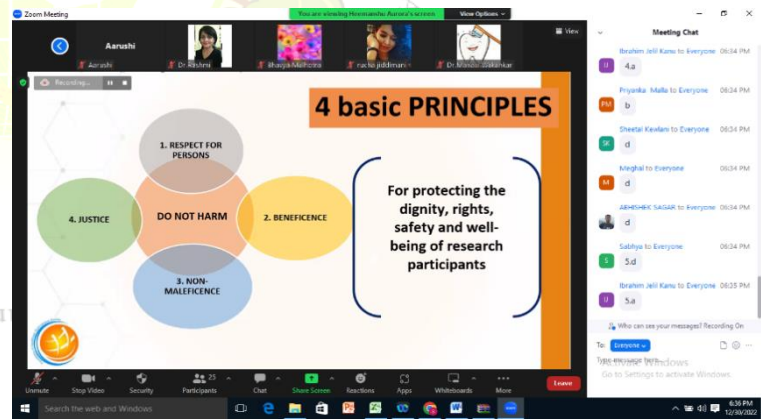
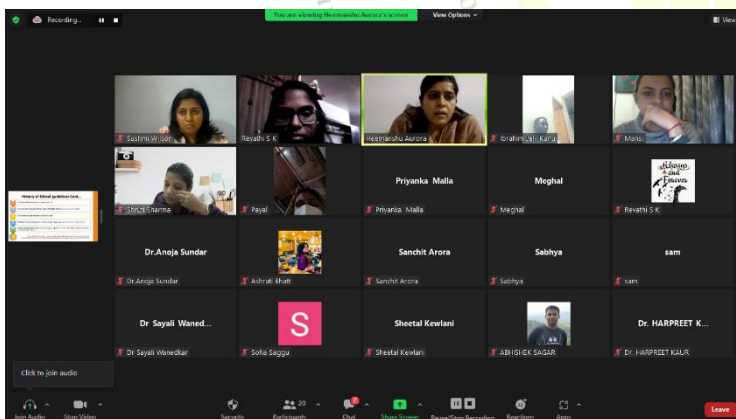
