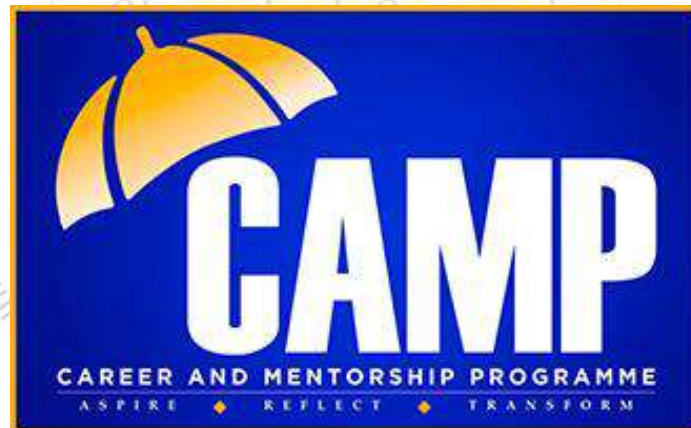




## EVENT REPORT

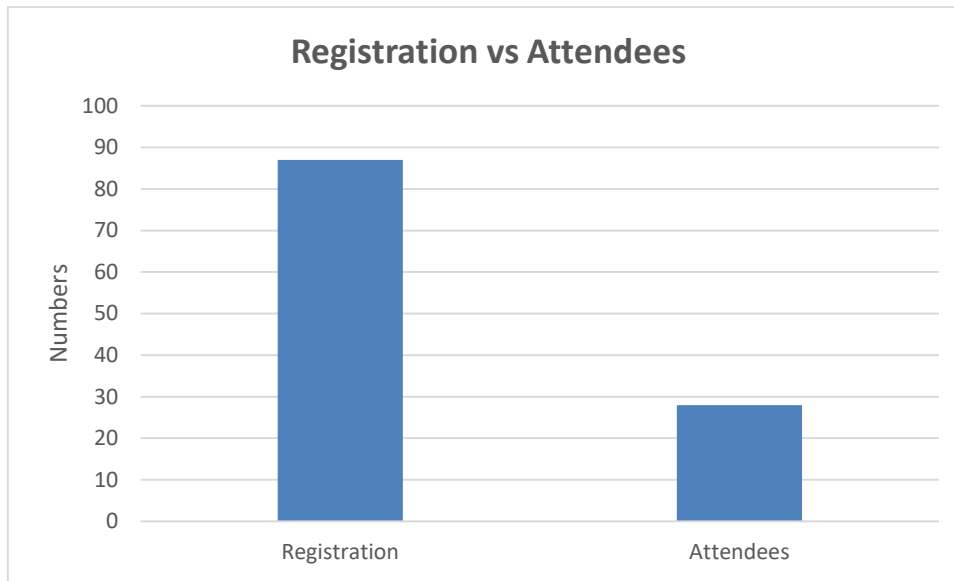
## SUMMARY

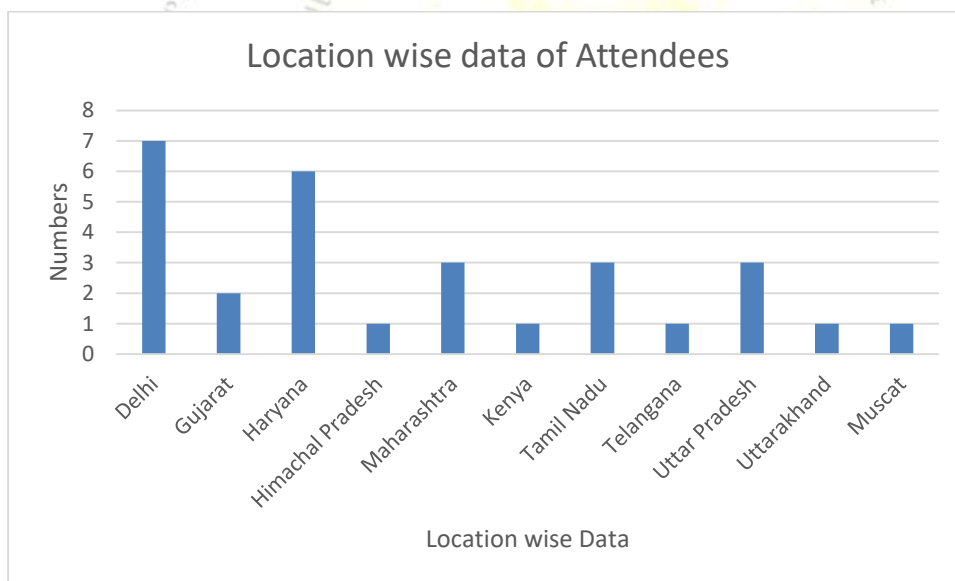

## HIGHLIGHTS

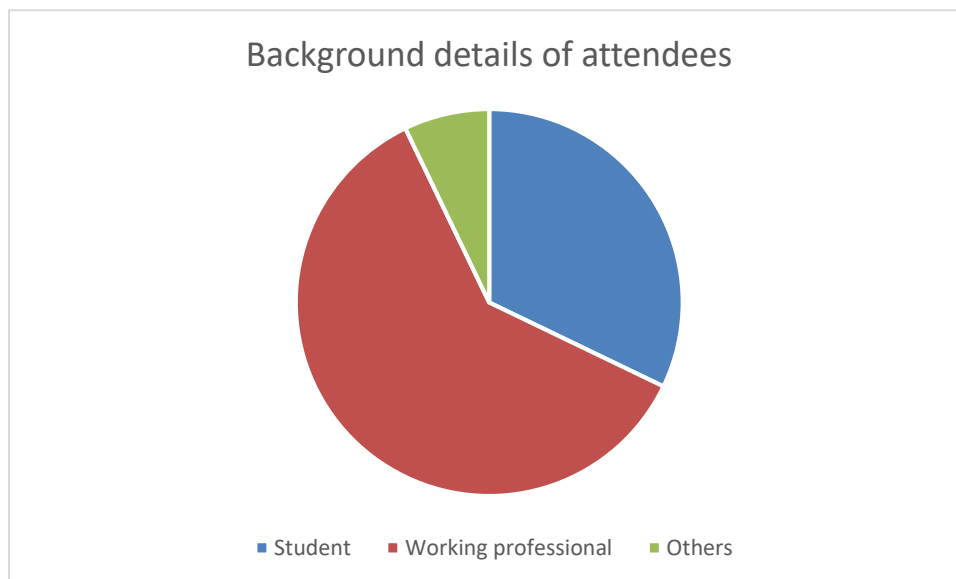
- There were 87 registrations made and 28 attendees attended the session out of which which 86% were female and 14% were male.

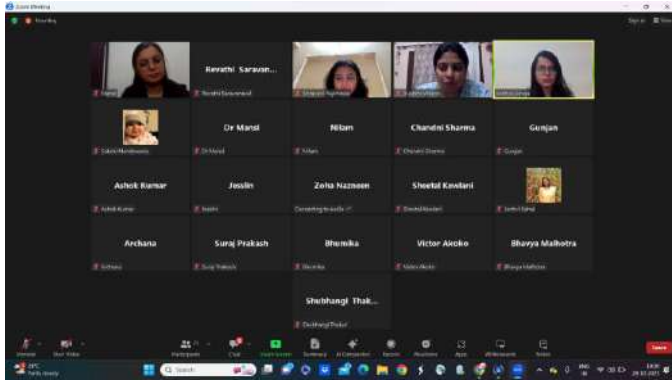
